

(please make your way to 'The House' after the Children's talk)




Bible Story Bags are available in the Vestibule. They are for children 6 years and under and the bags should be returned to the stand at the end of the service.

Cost £20 (includes Tea/coffee lunch and dinner. To book go to Eventbrite or PCI website.


FAITH IN THE FIRE
