All members of the public are welcome to attend for private prayer, to sit and reflect.

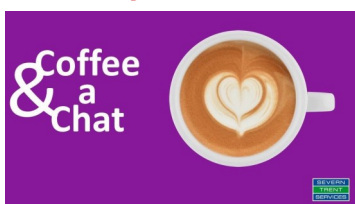
